

Barmès-Buecher Rosenberg Riesling Alsace

Due to its north/northeast orientation, riesling grown in the Rosenberg vineyard enjoys a more lengthy maturation on the vine. As such, Barmès-Buecher's example is characterized by admirable finesse.

VARIETIES: 100% Riesling

CLASSIFICATION: Alsace AOC

VINEYARDS: From a moderately sloped east/northeast facing vineyard in Wettolsheim. Selection massale utilized for new plantings.

VINEYARD SOILS: Clay, limestone, flint and chalk

FARMING: Biodynamic

WINEMAKING: Hand harvested, then triage on sorting table. Gentle slow pressing (duration 12 hours). Stainless Steel fermentation. No Malolactic fermentation.

AGING: 50% Stainless Steel, 50% Oak
