

Barmès-Buecher Steingrubler Gewürztraminer Alsace Grand Cru

Steingrubler, or "stone quarry" in German, provides an intriguing terroir for the vines planted here. Of the Grand Cru wines produced at Barmès-Buecher, it is those wines from the Steingrubler that are the most precocious in terms of revealing fruit, spice and mineral notes.

VARIETIES: 100% Gewürztraminer

CLASSIFICATION: Alsace Grand Cru AOC

VINEYARDS: From the south & southeast facing Grand Cru vineyard of Steingrubler in Alsace. Selection massale utilized for new plantings.

VINEYARD SOILS: Clay, marls, & limestone over bedrock of granite and sandstone

FARMING: Biodynamic

WINEMAKING: Hand harvested, then triage on sorting table. Gentle slow pressing (duration 12 hours). Stainless Steel fermentation. No Malolactic fermentation.

AGING: In stainless steel on lees for 11 months. Light filtration prior to bottling.
