

Delagrange Bourgogne Hautes-Côtes de Beaune Rouge

Domaine Delagrange's entry level pinot noir comes from 3.35 hectares of vineyards in the AOC of Bourgogne Hautes-Côtes de Beaune. It is a great introduction to the red wines of the domaine.

VARIETIES: 100% Pinot Noir

CLASSIFICATION: Bourgogne Hautes-Côtes de Beaune AOC

VINEYARDS / SOILS: Stony marl, reddish clay. 3.35 hectares of estate vineyards.

VINE AGE: 8 years. Planted at 10,000 vines per hectare.

FARMING: Sustainable

WINEMAKING: Manual harvest. 100% de-stemmed. Fermentation via native yeast for 15 days in temperature controlled open top fermenters with occasional punch down of cap.

AGING: 10 months in 60% in neutral barrel and 40% in stainless steel tank. Light fining and filtration prior to bottling.
