

Domaine Gallois Bourgogne Rouge

Domaine Gallois' 2013 Bourgogne rouge shows ripe fruit on the nose, along with a precise and focused palate. Fine tannins and a lengthy finish make for an over achieving pinot noir at its price point.

VARIETIES: 100% Pinot Noir

CLASSIFICATION: Bourgogne AOC

VINEYARDS / SOILS: Clay-limestone. From parcels just below Gevrey-Chambertin AOC and in Fixin.

VINE AGE: Between 15-30 years

FARMING: Sustainable

WINEMAKING: Manual harvest and 100% de-stemmed. Triage, 2-5 day cold-soak, fermentation via

native yeasts.

AGING: 18 months in used Burgundian barrel (228L).
