



Gitton "Belles Dames" Sancerre Blanc

From a 5 hectare parcel on flint soil, Les Belles Dames carries a dusty, edgy beam of acidity on a sturdy frame. This thirst quenching Sancerre begins to develop texture with age or one hour of decanting.

VARIETY: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

CLASSIFICATION: Sancerre AOC

VINEYARD : Les Belles Dames – South – South East facing vineyard (20-30% grade) at 235-265 meters above sea level.

SOILS : Sparnacien Limestone / Silex

SURFACE AREA : 5 hectares

VINES PLANTED : 1967 / 1968 /1980

VINIFICATION : Mechanical harvest. Fermentation in stainless steel tank at cool temperatures.

ELEVAGE : 9-10 months in stainless steel vat & neutral demi-muids.
