

Gitton "Les Romains" Sancerre Rosé

Sancerre Pinot Noir planted in 1965 on a small parcel known as Les Romains. A classic Sancerre rosé which benefits from 6 months of additional aging in the bottle before release.

VARIETY: 100% Pinot Noir

CLASSIFICATION: Sancerre AOC

VINEYARD: Les Romains – West facing vineyard (30% grade) at 260-280 meters above sea level.

SOILS: Silex-Flint / Sparnacien Limestone

SURFACE AREA: 1.2 hectares

VINE AGE: 50+ years

VINIFICATION: Mechanical harvest. Fermentation in stainless steel tank at cool temperatures.

ELEVAGE: Aging 4-5 months in stainless steel. Bottled late spring following vintage.
