

Château Tour Peyronneau Saint-Émilion Grand Cru

The 2014 vintage of Château Tour Peyronneau's Saint-Émilion is an elegant rendition of merlot and cabernet franc from the right bank of Bordeaux. Dark cherries and cocoa are balanced by a sleek minerality and fine tannic structure. A touch of spice and black tea nuances complete this very balanced red.

VARIETIES: 95% Merlot - 5% Cabernet Franc

APPELLATION: Saint-Émilion Grand Cru – Right Bank of Bordeaux

VINEYARDS: 12 hectares estate vineyards around villages of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens & Libourne

VINEYARD AGE + SOILS: 33 years. Predominantly clay, sand and gravel soils

FARMING: Organic

WINEMAKING: De-stemmed, triage with optical sorting machine. Fermentation in tank 28-36 days. No sulfur added.

AGING: 1/3 of the wine (from clay heavy soils) spends 12 months in new French oak. 2/3 in tank.
